

Marathon course description

Distance (mi)	Description
0	Start at the Pelton Creek trailhead, heading northeast on the Medicine Bow Rail Trail.
2.2	Use the underpass to cross underneath Wyoming Highway 230.
3.2	Cross Boswell Road. Be careful—watch for traffic!
5.6 (aid station)	Cross Forest Service Road 549 to reach the first aid station at Vienna trailhead.
10.6 (aid station)	Stop at the Woods Creek trailhead aid station. You will cross Wyoming Highway 230 at this aid station. You must stop and wait for race staff to give you the go ahead to cross the highway. There will be traffic traveling at high speeds along the highway. Race staff will not stop traffic for runners to cross the highway.
12.3	Continuing on the rail trail, you will reach the small community of Fox Park. You will turn left and run down the berm onto the dirt road (Forest Service Road 512). You will pass the community of Fox Park on your right. This turn will be marked. Be courteous to traffic while running on the roads.
12.5	Turn right on Forest Service Road 517. This turn will be marked. Continue on the road around the community of Fox Park.
13.1	Exit Forest Service Road 517 left onto the rail trail. This turn will be marked. Continue on the rail trail.
14.9 (aid station)	Cross Forest Service Road 517 to reach the Lincoln Gulch trailhead aid station. You will have reached the turnaround point for the half marathon. You may begin to encounter other racers on the trail, running both directions.
19.7 (aid station)	Cross Forest Service Road 540 to the Lake Owen South aid station. This road leads to the Lake Owen Campground. Be careful—watch for traffic! Continue along the rail trail after crossing the road.
20.3	Cross the entrance to the Lake Owen day use parking lot. This is the finish area. Be careful—watch for traffic and fans! Continue along the rail trail after crossing the road.
22.3-22.5 (aid station)	Turn right onto Forest Service Road 517. This turn will be marked. Continue along the road. You will be on this road for less than ¼ mile before turning around and going back to Lake Owen. The Dry Park aid station will be near the Dry Park trailhead parking lot. This is the final aid station.
25.1	After having passed the finish area once more, this time going south, you will turn left onto the Lake Owen loop (near the Lake Owen South aid station). This turn will be marked. You will cross one road and run past the campground. Be courteous to others recreating at the lake. Be careful—watch for traffic!
26.2	Finish on the northwest side of Lake Owen near the day use parking lot.
