
Getting to Lake Owen from Laramie

- To get to Lake Owen, head west out of Laramie on U.S. Highway 130 and go 22 miles
- Turn Left onto State Highway 11/WY-11 and continue 11 miles to Albany.
- Continue on Forest Road through Albany (it becomes FR 500).
- After 2.2 miles, turn left (the turn is not well marked) onto Forest Road 513.
- Continue 2.5 miles and turn left on FR 517.
- Continue 1.5 miles. At intersection, turn right and go 1.7 miles (on FR 540) to the Lake Owen Trailhead.



If you enter Lake Owen Campground as a destination in your GPS it will likely give you incorrect directions. The route it gives will bring you to a closed road that has not been open to the public for a couple years. Use the directions above. Driving time from Laramie is 1 hour.

If you come on Friday and plan to camp, the Lake Owen Campground is open, and there is dispersed camping in the vicinity. The large open area, about 3 miles before you get to Lake Owen, is very popular with the RV and ATV crowd. It is a large clearing, but expect a lot of company if you camp there.
